Business highlights in 2015

- Technology transfer is an important component of Siemens' business in Malaysia. The company has always ensured local skill-set development and a structured transfer of technical know-how to local business partners. SMHRail Sdn Bhd, one of Siemens' consortium partners for the Klang Valley MRT (KVMRT) project, became the first metro train assembly plant outside of Europe when Siemens awarded the company the Certificate of Acceptance for fulfilling technical and infrastructure requirements at its LMG Railcar Assembly Plant facility in Rasa, Hulu Selangor. This complete technology transfer is part of the KVMRT Project Offset Program commitment. It empowers our consortium partner to fully assemble the highly sophisticated Siemens Inspiro metro train, in Malaysia.
- The Power Generation Services Division chartered a successful year by securing two major contracts with the customer TNB Remaco. The long-term service agreement for the Prai Combined Cycle Power Plant is for 20 years and the long-term maintenance agreement for the Connaught Bridge Combined Cycle Power Plant is for 14 years.
- The Energy Management Division will be supplying 51 units of 275 kV gas-insulated switchgear (GIS) to the PETRONAS RAPID Project. These GIS units are made by Siemens India.

- The Process Industries and Drives Division secured a contract to supply spare parts as part of the Tanjung Pelepas Port refurbishment project.
- Siemens has been active in Malaysia since 1908.
